

Call for Applications: SWGS 100 TA Positions (Graduate Students Only)

CSWGS solicits applications for two graduate student teaching assistant positions for SWGS 100, "Introduction to the Study of Women, Gender and Sexuality."

One TA will work with Prof. Michael Dango in **Fall 2025**; the due date for those applications is May 13, 2025.

One TA will work with Prof. Vic Overdorf in **Spring 2026**; the due date for those applications is September 29, 2025.

Assistant teaching in an introductory course helps build a teaching record for those who wish to apply for academic positions in women, gender, and sexuality studies programs and departments, or for positions that might be affiliated with these programs and departments.

This assistantship offers first-hand teaching experience, familiarity with the debates and issues taken up in an introductory course, as well as a chance to discuss syllabus design and assignments.

Duties include attendance at all classes, some grading, office hours to assist students with assignments, and occasional course lectures. Remuneration is \$3,500. This opportunity is designed to prepare graduate students to be instructors of record in a future semester.
